GUIDELINES FOR THE MARRIAGE SERVICE IN THE EASTERN ORTHODOX CHURCH

Items Needed for the Eastern Orthodox Marriage Service

- Marriage License. This should be picked up well in advance of the wedding. It is good for 60 days.
- 2. Wedding Crowns.
- 3. Two Wedding Candles. The Bride and Groom hold decorated candles with white ribbons.
- 4. Rings for the Bride and Groom. They will be blessed during the ceremony

Optional Items

- 5. Silver Tray
- 6. Two Additional Wedding Candles. One is held by the Kumbaro (or Kumbara) and the other one by the Best Man or Maid of Honor.
- 7. Candied Almonds (Koufetes)
- 8. White Runner for the center aisle (75 feet)
- 9. Two bouquets of flowers for either side of the Royal Doors.
- 10. Orthodox Marriage Service booklet that explains what is happening during the service.
- 11. Organist. If using an organist, the organist must know the Orthodox Wedding Service.

Rules and Regulations to be Respected

- 1. Please make sure that your church dues are current (for Orthodox members).
- 2. If possible, all financial obligations to the Church should be made in advance.
- 3. The wedding date and rehearsal should be set well before the service.
- 4. If you choose to have the church choir, there is a \$50.00 fee paid to the Church.
- 5. Typically, we use only the Orthodox Marriage music & hymns.
- Only the Orthodox Priest can perform the service. A non-Orthodox clergyman of another denomination may attend and offer a congratulatory blessing to the couple at the conclusion of the service.
- The Orthodox person must receive Holy Communion on the Sunday before their marriage.

8.	The Kumbaro/Kumbara must be Orthodox and in good standing with the Orthodox Church
